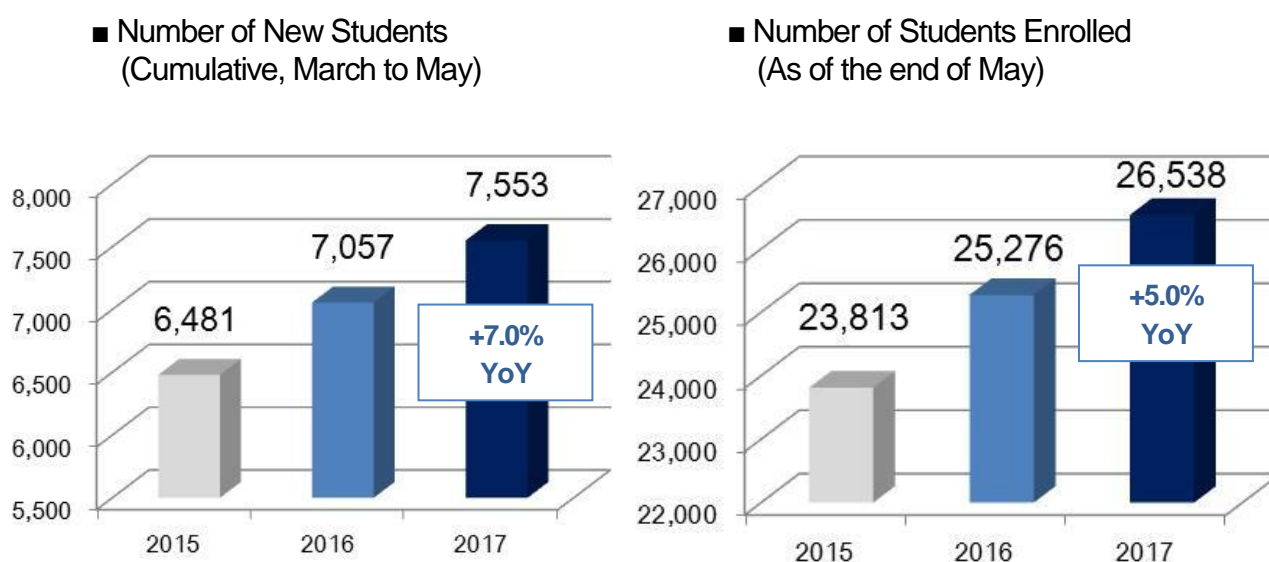


**Update of Number of Students Enrolled  
As of the End of the First Quarter of the Fiscal Year Ending February 2018 (preliminary figures)**

Tokyo Individualized Educational Institute, Inc. (TIEI) has reached the final year of Dynamic Challenge 2017, its medium-term management plan that started in the fiscal year ended February 2016. TIEI will do its utmost to strongly promote the three growth strategies set forth in this plan, including “Enhancement of educational capabilities.” In addition, TIEI will further accelerate growth and press forward with the aim of increasing its social value through sustainable growth. In line with this, TIEI announces preliminary figures for the number of new students and the number of students enrolled as of the end of the first quarter of the fiscal year ending February 2018 to show the status of its progress under the plan.

**■ New schools opened March to May 2017**

March: Tokyo Individualized Educational Institute Ebisu School (Shibuya-ku, Tokyo)

March: Tokyo Individualized Educational Institute Gotanda School (Shinagawa-ku, Tokyo)

April: Benesse Writing Class Shinyurigaoka School (Asao-ku, Kawasaki-shi, Kanagawa)

April: Benesse Writing Class Musashiurawa School (Minami-ku, Saitama-shi, Saitama); the first Benesse Writing Class to be opened in Saitama Prefecture

Also, on June 7, 2017, TIEI opened the Machiya School (Arakawa-ku, Tokyo), the Ashiya School (Ashiya-shi, Hyogo) and the JR Ibaraki Ekimae School (Ibaraki-shi, Osaka) as new individualized instruction schools. With the opening of these three new schools, TIEI operates a total of 235 individualized instruction schools nationwide.
